CBA seeks a dynamic and enthusiastic Part-Time Zumba Instructor to join our Health Access team. The ideal candidate will have a passion for dance, fitness, and motivating others to achieve their health and wellness goals. As a Zumba Instructor, you will be responsible for leading engaging and energetic Zumba classes for participants of all fitness levels. This individual will be working under the supervision of the Health Access Program Manager and in partnership with other program staff of CBA.

Essential Functions/Responsibilities

- Lead Zumba classes with a focus on providing a fun and effective workout experience.
 Incorporate a variety of dance styles and music genres to keep participants motivated and engaged.
- Develop and plan Zumba class routines that cater to participants with different fitness levels and abilities. Stay current with Zumba trends and integrate new moves and music into classes.
- Create a positive and inclusive class environment. Motivate and encourage participants
 to achieve their fitness goals. Provide modifications for different fitness levels and
 ensure a safe workout environment.
- Arrive early to set up the class space and ensure all necessary equipment is available.
 Coordinate with CBA staff to address any equipment or facility needs.
- Keep accurate records of class attendance. Communicate with Health Access Program manager regarding any issues or concerns related to class participation.
- Assist in promoting Zumba classes through various channels, such as social media, flyers, and word-of-mouth. Encourage participants to share their experiences and recruit new members.

- A passion for culturally appropriate and equitable health access
- Possess a valid Zumba certification from a recognized Zumba education provider.
- Previous experience as a Zumba Instructor is desirable, but enthusiastic individuals with a strong dance and fitness background may be considered.
- Excellent verbal communication skills to effectively instruct and motivate participants.
- Consistent and punctual attendance for scheduled classes.
- Bilingual Spanish speaker preferred
- Passionate about working in the community and wants to have lots of fun!
